

Memorandum of Understanding
between
University of Bremen
Faculty 08
and
National Taiwan University
Department of Geosciences

Based on the existent academic relationships between the Faculty 08 of the University of Bremen (FB 08) and the Department of Geosciences, National Taiwan University (NTU), the following contract regarding the collaboration between both institutions is finalized with the objective of deepening their collaboration in research and teaching, as well as in other academic affairs.

Article 1

The collaboration extends to all mutually established aspects of both academic organizations, and includes joint research as well as the exchange of information related to the joint research.

Article 2

Both academic organizations agree to the exchange of scientists and students and release these, to whatever extent possible, for the participation in the arranged teaching and research programs.

Article 3

The exchange of students and instructors can be further arranged through an annexation. Both sides ensure that this exchange is carried out on a reciprocal basis.

Article 4

There are no financial obligations for the contract partners because of this contract. However, both will seek to raise third-party (external) funds to finance the activities that arise because of this contract.

Article 5

The implementation of the proposals stands, providing that the requisite budget funds are available to the contract partners.

Article 6

The contract partners agree to promote the exchange of academic publications. Both parties strive for the publication of important research in their respective academic journals.

Article 7

The collaborative academic facilities of both organizations commit to the mutual provision of information about their respective congresses, academic conferences and seminars, as well as to the exchange of results and findings as is legally possible.

Article 8

This collaboration can be changed upon mutual agreement or extended based on mutual, written arrangement.

Article 9

This Memorandum of Understanding takes effect with the complete undersigning of both parties and is thenceforth effective for a period of five years.

Article 10

After the completion of the contract period, an active extension is required from both sides. A termination of the collaboration is possible within a period of at least six months to the end of the calendar year.

Article 11

This Memorandum of Understanding in English language is signed in four original copies – two copies for each organization.
